


KNOW all men by these presents that we *David Coker and*

*William H Babell* Esquire, Governor of Virginia, and his successors,  
for the use of the commonwealth, in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, to  
which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors  
and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Scaled and dated  
this *1<sup>st</sup>* day of *May* 1808.

THE condition of the above obligation is such that whereas a marriage is shortly  
intended to be solemnised between the above bound *David Coker*  
and *Silva Coker* daughter of *Isaac*  
*Coker*  
of *Green* County, if therefore, there shall be no lawful cause to obstruct the  
said marriage, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full  
force and virtue.


