Will of Joseph English

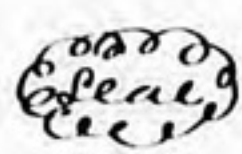
In the name of God, Amen, I Joseph English of the Township of Egg

 mind memory and understanding, do make and publish this
 my last will and testament in manner following, that is to say
 First it is my will and I do order that all my just debts and
 funeral expenses be duly paid and satisfied, and a suitable
 tomb stone be erected to my memory. I give and bequeath unto my
 beloved wife Ann W. English all my household goods and chat-
 tels and all manner of personal property whatsoever kind and
 wheresoever situated during her natural life, and after death
 then it is my will that my son Christopher L. English have the
 horses and wagons, and all other farming utensils, plow har-
 rows, of whatever kind, I give and devise unto my beloved
 wife Ann W. English all my Real Estate of whatever kind and
 wheresoever situated during her natural life, and after her
 death it is my will that her funeral expenses, and a suitable tom-
 stone be erected to her memory, and paid for from my personal
 property after the death of my wife Ann W. English then it is my
 will that my son Christopher L. English shall have all on the
 east side of the road leading by my house to the main road
 adjoining lands of Leuel English and James T. English also I
 give unto my son Christopher L. English after the death of my wife
 Ann W. English all of my right title and interest of salt mead-
 ows known as the Parbeck meadows and lying on the North

 North East side and joins Nathaniel Riesley on the east side of tract
