Regarding Select Descendants of Francis Andrews:

Clarification of misinformation about John Andrews I and his descendants, John II, John IV, John V, their respective birth dates and spouses Created by Doug Couch in 2023

Various historical and genealogical compilations of information on these families often provide sketchy, incomplete data as well as occasional errors connecting data to the wrong person. There are two main causes in addition to any research or editorial errors:

- 1) People named their children after their siblings such that in a given area, one might have had several of the exact same name and over time, this was multiplied. Also the same person might use their first name one time, their middle name another time, or a nickname yet another and end up being referred to by any of these in official documents (which themselves bear errors from time to time). As if that wasn't enough, individuals changed the spelling of their names (including surname) or just changed their names entirely.
- 2) Official records very often do not give any information or sometimes not even a clue as to which person of that name the record refers to. Educated guesswork kicks in, trying to figure all that out, and just like the records the data was drawn from, this guesswork doesn't always report accurately.

Misc Note: Re the resource book, Genealogical History of John and Mary Andrews (etc.), the John Andrews of the title is not one of the John Andrews in the successive lineage John I-V discussed below.

John Andrews I, son of Francis Andrews I

- **Birth:** History of Fairfield, Vol. 2, by Schenck in 1903, p.441 gives his birth place as Essex, England with no date. Vol. 1, by Schenck in 1889, p.350 gives his birth date as 27 Sep 1646.
- Marriage: History of Fairfield, Vol. 1, by Schenck in 1889, erroneously gives his spouse as Sarah daughter of Simon Couch. She corrects this error in Vol. 2, by Schenck in 1903, giving his spouse as Bethiah Kirby daughter of John Kirby, without a date (text cites records of Middletown, Conn.).
- **Death:** not given

John Andrews II, son of John Andrews I

- Birth: Genealogical History of John and Mary Andrews...1640...Descendants to 1872, by Andrews in 1872, p.28 & p.31 gives his birth date as 24 Oct 1679 in Fairfield, Conn. This date is reiterated in other works.
 - Regarding John II's birth year, Schenk Vol. I (which was published 12 years later than Andrews' work), after correcting the spouse of John Andrews I in Vol. 2, Schenck assigns Sarah Couch as the spouse of (Ens.) John Andrews II (born 1679), stating that they were married "about 1678" (Schenck, Vol. 1, p.441). Clearly this is another error of mistaken identity (or poor proofreading).
- Marriages: History and Genealogy of the Families of Old Fairfield, Vol. 01A, by Jacobus, pp.20-21 gives his birth, marriages and death information. m(1). Eleanor Burr, daughter of Daniel, born 26 Oct 1680. m(2). Abigail Sturgis, widow of Simon Couch.
- Death: 1728, Fairfield. (ibid)

John Andrews III, (Dea.), son of John Andrews II

- Birth: Genealogical History of John and Mary Andrews...1640...Descendants to 1872, by Andrews in 1872, p.28 gives his birth date as 6 Aug 1707.
- Marriage: Genealogical History of John and Mary Andrews...1640...Descendants to 1872, by Andrews in 1872, p.28 gives his spouse as Sarah Couch, daughter of Simon Couch, married 28 Oct 1730 (also in Schenck Vol. I and Jacobus Vol. 01A) — [Note: Oddly, the Schenck Vol. 1 has this marriage correctly in addition to the erroneous information re the spouse of John I. Then in her Vol. 2, she shows her married to John II with the impossible estimated marriage date 1678. Then also in Vol. 2, she has Sarah Couch married to John IV.]
- Death: Colonial Cemetery inscription, 28 Mar 1771

John Andrews IV, (Capt.) son of John Andrews III

- Birth: Genealogical History of John and Mary Andrews...1640...Descendants to 1872, by Andrews in 1872, p.28 gives his birth date as 17 Mar 1734. His birth date is also given in Schenck, Vol. 1 & Vol. 2. confirmed by birth record.
- Marriage: History and Genealogy of the Families of Old Fairfield, Vol. unknown, p.28 (I only have an image of pages 28 & 29, and they appear to be a later edition than the full copy of volumes I viewed online.) Temperance Cable, daughter of George Cable, married John Andrews IV 28 Mar 1758 as her first husband.
- Death: 19 Nov 1777 in Westport (ibid) confirmed by cem. inscr.

John Andrews V, son of John Andrews IV

- **Birth:** History and Genealogy of the Families of Old Fairfield, Vol. unknown, p.28 Est 1759 revised: Est 1757 re cem. inscr.
- Marriage: Lydia Gorham, married 9 Oct 1783 (ibid)
- Death: 29 May 1825 in Westport (ibid) revised 1823 re cem. inscr.

History of Fairfield, Vol. 1, by Schenck in 1889

- 1. John Andrews I shown as having Sarah Couch as his spouse.
- 2. Shows "their" children born 1679-1680 when Sarah would be 73-75.
- 3. Refers to Mary Andrews as sister to Simon Couch, thus referencing an earlier Simon Couch as this Sarah's father (although that Siimon also had a daughter, Sarah). Further, although Mary the wife of that earlier Simon is probably Mary Francis, there is no known document showing that his wife, Mary, was the daughter of Francis Andrews (father of John Andrews I).* (comment on name error, see second image on this page)
- 4. Quotes a 1733 will which mentions wife Sarah and daughter Abigail (Edwards) as though they were the wife and daughter of John Andrews I. It appears that Sarah and her siblings in this will are all children of Simon Couch II & Abigail Sturgis (except for an unnamed daughter, widow of Thomas; who remains unknown) and appears that Sarah is not wife of John Andrews I as cited (however, that Sarah "is" later the wife of John Andrews III, grandson of John Andrews I).

The various commentary in this single paragraph image would seem to have been cobbled together. **Schenck Errors:**

JOHN I. s. of Francis Andrews I. of F. m. Sarah d. of Simon Couch. Their children were John, b. 24. Oct. 1679 & Sarah, 12. Jan. 1680, & d. in 1683. F. T. Rec. He with Simon Couch, who m. his sister Mary Andrews, purchased of the other heirs, & of their mother the long-lot & other lands of Francis Andrews I. at Fairfield. He was deeded several parcels of land by his father at Bankside, & owned a considerable land at Turkey-hill. In the distribution of his estate in 1733 w. Sarah is mentioned; d. Abigail w. of William Edwards; d. Hannah w. of Samuel Osborn; d. — w. Thomas Couch; d. Isabel w. Robert Rumsey & d. Deborah w. of Jacob P. Jones.

Comment by Jacobus further down the page:

† Mrs. Schenck with happy certainty calls her dau. of Francis Andrews, which is not impossible; yet the records she quotes do not specify the relationship as her quotations seem to imply.

History of Fairfield, Vol. 2, by Schenck in 1903

- 1. In the first paragraph, Schenck corrects the spouse error re John Andrews I which was cited in the previous Vol. I image. She continues by citing a correct will (of John Kirby, him being the father-in-law of John Andrews I).
- 2. In the second paragraph, she cites similar rights to estate lands re John Andrews II (I haven't researched that part). Then she goes on to state that John Andrews II married Sarah Couch. However, Sarah Couch did not marry John Andrews II either.
- 3. In the third paragraph, she cites the spouse of John Andrews III as Abigail (no surname). John Andrews III did not marry an Abigail. However, Abigail Sturgis was the second wife of John Andrews II.
- 4. In the fourth paragraph, she cites Sarah Couch yet again as the spouse of John Andrews IV.
 - a. It is worth noting that there was a Sarah daughter of Simon Couch I, contemporary with John Andrews II within ten years, and another Sarah daughter of Simon Couch II born 1706, contemporary within one year with John Andrews III, whom she "did" marry.
 - b. Also, Abigail Sturgis, who married John Andrews II, married him as the widow of Simon Couch II. Her daughter, Sarah Couch, married John Andrews III. Schenck Errors:

John Andrews I. b. in Essex, England, was a s. of Francis Andrews I. of Hartford & later of Fairfield, did not marry Sarah d. of Simon Couch of Fairfield as stated in Vol. I. p. 350; but according to the town records of Middletown, Conn., he m. Bethiah Kirby b. Feb. 14. 1658 d. of John Kirby of Middletown. John Kirby, the father was b. in 1623 & d. in 1677. In the distribution of the estate of John Kirby by his widow Elizabeth, John Andrews of Fairfield was deeded, "in right of his wife's interest in her father's estate," her portion of his estate.

John Andrews 2. afterwards deeded, "by virtue of my father's right in my grand-father Kirby's estate certain lands within the town of Middletown, to my brother-in-law Richard Osborn of Eastchester, near Stamford, Conn."—Fairfield Town Rec. John Andrews 2, son of John 1. m. Sarah d. of Simon Couch about 1678.

John Andrews 3. s. of John 2. m. Abigail ——— & was bapt. at Christ's Church, Fairfield, with his son John 27. June, 1708.—Vol. I. p. 150.

John Andrews 4. son of John 3. married Sarah d. of Simon Couch Oct. 28. 1730 Their children were: Sarah b. Aug. 6. 1731; John March 17. 1734; Abraham Aug. 23. 1735; Abigail Dec. 13. 1736; Ellenor Aug. 4. 1738; Samuel Feb. 23. 1740; Isabel Sept. 20. 1742; Simon Oct. 28. 1744.—Reg. of Births, Marriages & Deaths of the Town of Fairfield 1692 to 1855. Sarah Andrews m. 1st Jonathan Nash & 2d Lieut. Nathan Godfrey of Green's Farms. Ellenor m.
